Plan for Mastery of Content for Carnegie Unit Courses

In accordance with Process Standard 13.2, the Clarksdale Municipal School District will implement the following plan to ensure the mastery of content for Carnegie unit courses for the 2020-2021 school year. The plan is as follows:

- CMSD will provide students with a minimum of 240 minutes of instruction daily. Students will be able to receive instruction in one of the three modes of instruction due to COVID-19. Instruction will be offered face to face (synchronous) or a combination of face to face and virtual (hybrid). Learning packs will be given to students who need them.
- CMSD will offer support both during the school hours and after hours for parents and students. Teachers will have office hours during the day for parents and/or students to contact them. Each school will also have after school instructional support. Additionally, there will be intervention/remediation time built into the instructional daily schedule to support students who are not mastering content.
- Students will be assessed throughout the school year. Universal screeners, progress monitoring, quizzes, weekly tests, and nine weeks tests will be administered. At the end of each nine weeks, assessments will be administered to determine the mastery of skills. Students must demonstrate mastery of content and receive the minimum grade required to receive credit. If students do not demonstrate mastery, credit recovery will be provided based on the guidelines of the district.
